

PROJECT ADMINISTRATION



Expenses of ~ ₹ 14 L. were incurred during Oct '23.



Thus far, ~ ₹ **1.46 cr.** has been spent for Phase 2 of the project (during July, Aug, Sep, Oct '23). Total Phase II expenses July, Aug, Sept, Oct 2023

On the Fundraising front, we crossed the Rs. 50 Cr (value of donations) milestone in June '23.



Rs. 2.25 cr. donated in August, Rs. 2.82 cr. in September '23 and Rs. 1.23 cr. in Oct '23.
