- Above 2nd floor- Column Casting 7%



- Ground floor Column 63% Completed, casting reached first floor level







Thematic Art, Evergreen Memories

- We are thrilled to have the IDC take creative and executional charge of art and wayfinding on the Evergreen grounds.
- The IDC team comprising Prof Raja Mohanty, Prof Arun Mascarenhas and Prof Shilpa Ranade have come on board to help with the art and wayfinding on the Evergreen premises once the project is up. The hunt is on for sculptors and muralists to submit proposals to the IDC for their creative work.
- Two generous alumni from C'98 Manu Varma and Sandesh Joshi are sponsoring 2 out of the 3 iconic sculptures that will enhance the civil structure of the hostel complex by making the environment vibrant and adding character.
- Apart from the sculptures, there will be 3 murals one per hostel that will be art-works that define the personality of each of the hostels. As on date, all of the murals area are available for generous and artistically-inclined alumni to sponsor.

Gamma Fund raising

- Alumni cannot be far behind in giving the hostels a personality. Signs of a typically IITian sense of playfulness and some quirkiness are visible in a few naming choices for instance, an H8 trio that has decided to name their rooms as per their *nicknames* on campus !
- Two alumni sponsors from the 70s are considering naming the facility they donated (a floor and a wing) after plays they were a part of during their campus years, plays which won many inter-college competitions.
