□Highlights

The Reveal:

- A preview of the donor recognition templates for donors that have contributed towards naming the living areas of the hostels i.e. room, wing or floor.
- > And the signage for honoring Patron Donors and Charter Donors
- Next month's report will include the signage for large amenities such as the Café, the Lounge etc., as well as outdoor areas such as the Banyan Tree Enclave.

Construction update:

- ➤ 100% Casting completed for the 9th Floor of H-7
- ➤ 100% Casting completed for 7th Floor of H-8 and H-21

How we got here:

- Through a competitive bidding process, we engaged a specialised signage agency 'Graphics Beyond' to developed the signage and way finding markers in the project.
- A few themes they suggested that could reflect in the way-finding and signage formats, were:
 - Nature inspired from the names of the 3 hostels -- 'Lady of the Lake',
 'Woodlands' and 'Raintree'; the greenery in the hostel complex, serene waters
 of Powai lake nearby
 - The driving sentiment behind the project Evergreen the permanent emotional bond ...
 - between alumni and the institute
 - between hostels and its residents
 - between generous donors supporting future generations; creating their legacy and a gift to the future

No guesses for which option emerged as the first choice....

The Creative detailing:

- A strong sub-theme -- Alumni support and generous contributions are building blocks – not just of this project but of IIT Bombay's future
 - **Depict stones as stepping stones** each stone, an alumnus, each stone an act of "giving back", each stone an acknowledgement that every contribution matters, and adds up to the whole
 - River pebbles, not any stone smooth, rounded edges, representing the softness and tenderness of the sentiment behind each contribution.
- Representation:
 - one name, one pebble, one contributor recognition is individual.
 - Size of stone acknowledges approx. size of contribution. Bigger the stone in the water, bigger the ripples.
 - All similar shapes finally, we are all alumni of the same institute
 - *clustered together, in harmonious collages, yet not ordered* representing the joint effort of all of us, propagating outwards in an ever growing fraternity.

Creative inspirational thoughts:


- Building blocks & stepping stones Alumni contributions form the basis for this inspirational and mammoth project
- Sum of parts All contributions add up to achieve a big task
- Everyone counts no contribution is less important



Depictions:

- Clustered, in situ, and in prominent locations The donor acknowledgements for rooms, wings and floors will be near the lift lobby on each floor.
- Arranged in abstract shapes growing inorganically, radiating outwards, ever-growing alumni fraternity & their support
- In house colors of each hostel The pebbles will be in 3 different colours,
 one colour for each hostel
- Proportional surface area allocation The largest pebble will honour the donor for the floor, the mid-sized the donors for wings, and the many smaller pebbles those who've named a room. Empty pebbles are for aesthetics only....




