Construction update:

- Slab casting till 9th Floor (Top Floor) completed for all the three hostel buildings
- Blockwork, Internal plaster, water proofing, gypsum plaster, flooring and toilet tiling work initiated
- Procurement of Non-GC items in action

□ CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

H7:


- Structural Work: RCC (LMR & OHT slab) 100% complete.
- Masonry & Plastering: Blockwork complete; internal plastering up to 100% on floors 5-8..
- Waterproofing & Gypsum: Waterproofing and gypsum plastering 100% up to the 7th floor; higher floors in progress.
- Flooring & Tiling: Room flooring complete up to the 7th floor; toilet tiling 100% on the 5th floor, progressing on others.

H8:

- Structural Work: LMR & OHT slab 40% completed.
- Masonry & Plastering: Blockwork 50% on the 9th floor; internal plastering 100% up to the 8th floor.
- Waterproofing & Gypsum: 100% up to the 7th floor; higher floors in progress.
- Flooring: Completed up to the 6th floor;
 work in progress on the 7th floor.

H21:

- Structural Work: LMR & OHT slab 100% completed.
- Masonry & Plastering: Blockwork 100% completed up to the 9th floor; internal plastering 100% up to the 7th floor, with the 8th floor in progress.
- Waterproofing & Gypsum:
 Waterproofing 100% up to the 8th floor;
 gypsum plastering 100% up to the 7th floor, 8th floor in progress.
- Flooring: 100% completed on floors 5 and 6; work in progress on higher floors.




